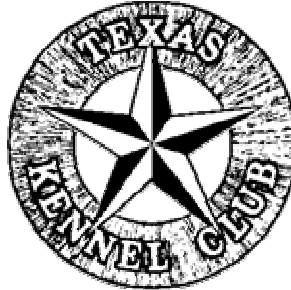

**Measuring for the Trials:** Dogs that do not have official AKC Jump Height Cards **MUST** be measured **before they compete**. Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) will **not** be available to measure dogs for their official AKC Jump Height card at this trial. However, **ALL** dogs, excluding those in the 24" and 26" jump height **MUST** be measured or they cannot compete by the judge of record.

**Check-In:** Self-service check-in begins at 7:00 AM both days. **Check-in on subsequent days is not needed once you have checked in.** If you indicated on your dog's entry form that your dog had an official AKC Jump Height card, you will be able to pick up your handler envelope containing armband stickers for the weekend. If your dog needs to be measured, or you did not indicate on your dog's entry form that your dog had an official AKC Jump Height card, your dog must be measured or its jump height card must be inspected before you receive your armbands. See the trial secretary for your armbands.

**Running Orders & Course Maps:** Each judge will supply course maps – please take **ONE** copy of only the course you are going to run so we will have sufficient copies for every exhibitor. Running orders will be posted at the gates and in prominent places both upstairs and downstairs.

**Arrival/Setup:** The site opens at 7:00 A.M. both days.

**Concession Information:** We will have concessions on site. You may bring your own food, but please, no glass containers or alcoholic beverages.

**Day-to-Day Move-Ups:** If you complete a title and would like to move up, submit a move-up form no later than 30 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line. Move-up forms (printed on brightly-colored paper) will be at the check-in table. Dogs moving up will run at the end of the new class. **You may not move-up if you do not complete a move-up form – NO EXCEPTIONS!** Same day move-ups are not allowed.

**Veterinarian (On Call):** Emergency Animal Clinic of Collin County, 10225 S. Custer Road, Plano, TX 75023, 214.547.9900. Map and directions will be available at the trial for this clinic as well as a clinic (daytime hours only) located near the trial site.

**Direction to the Trial Site:** The town of McKinney is about 33 miles northeast of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 3.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles to the site which is on the left.
